

Make squares of BUCILLA "Wool and Shetland Wool," 2 oz. balls or BEAR BRAND, FLEISHER'S or BOTANY Machine Washable Winsom,

2 oz. skeins

Use "BOYE" or "DIANA" CROCHET HOOK, Size G for all pattern squares except No. 39 Use "BOYE" or "DIANA" AFGHAN HOOK, Size G for No. 39-OR SIZE YOU REQUIRE TO OBTAIN GAUGE


GAUGE: Each square approximately 8 ins. square


IMPORTANT-To help you make full use of patterns given in this book, where feasible, we have given "multiple of ch sts" required on foundation or starting ch for 1 repeat of pattern.

Multiple of ch sts is not given for simple patterns requiring 1 ch for each st, nor for patterns starting at center.

For each additional repeat of pattern desired, add required multiple of ch sts to number of sts on foundation ch given in instructions.

For example: To add to width of Pattern No. 10, see page 7, ch 4 more than given in instructions for each extra shell required; to make narrower ch 4 less for each shell to be eliminated.





No. 3
Multiple of 3 ch sts

With A, ch 35 for lower edge.

Row 1—right side—Work 1 dc in 5th ch from hook for first V-st, * skip 2 ch, work 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc—all in next ch for V-st; repeat from * across ch; 11 V-sts.

Row 2—Ch 4, turn, 1 dc in ch-1 space of first V-st; 1 V-st in ch-1 space of each V-st across row, end last V-st in last space; 11 V-sts. Repeat row 2 until 14 rows—about 8 ins. from beg. Fasten off.

Note-All rounds are worked from right side.

Round 1—right side—With A, ch 4, join with sl st in first st to form ring, ch 3, work 2 dc in ring, * ch 3 for corner, work 3 dc—a shell—in ring; repeat from * twice more, ch 3, join with sl st in top of ch 3; 4 shells

Ch 3 at beg. of round counts as 1 dc.

Round 2—SI st in each of next 2 dc, sl st into first ch-3 space, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc—all in same space for first corner, * ch 2, work 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc—all in next corner space; repeat from * twice more, ch 2, join with sl st in top of first ch 3; 8, 3-dc shells.

Round 3—SI st in each of next 2 dc, sl st into first ch-3 space, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc—all in same space for first corner, * ch 2, 3 dc in next space, ch 2, work 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc—all in next space for corner; repeat from * twice more, ch 2, 3 dc in next space, ch 2, join with sl st in top of first ch 3; 12 shells.

Round 4—SI st in each of next 2 dc, sI st into first ch-3 space, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc—all in same space for first corner, + * ch 2, 3 dc in next space *; repeat between *'s once more, work ch 2, 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc—all in next corner space; repeat from + twice more; repeat between *'s twice, ch 2, join as before; 16 shells. Continue in this way having 1 more shell between corners in each successive round until 8 rounds from beg., ending last round join with sI st in top of ch 3; 32 shells. About 8 ins. square. Fasten off.


No. 2 Multiple of 2 ch sts

With B, ch 36 for lower edge.

Row 1—right side—Work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, * ch 1, skip next ch, 1 sc in next ch; repeat from * across ch; 35 sts.

Row 2—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in first sc, * ch 1, skip next ch 1, 1 sc in next sc; repeat from * across.

Repeat row 2 until 33 rows—about 8 ins. from beg. Fasten off.



No. 4 Multiple of 8 ch sts

With B, ch 42 for lower edge.

Row 1—right side—Work 1 dc in 4th ch from hook, 1 dc in each of next 4 ch, * ch 4, skip next 4 ch, 1 dc in each of next 4 ch; repeat from * 3 times more, 1 dc in each of last 2 ch.

Row 2—Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, 1 dc in each of next 5 dc, * ch 4, skip next ch 4, 1 dc in each of next 4 dc; repeat from * 3 times more, 1 dc in next dc, 1 dc in top of turning ch.

Row 3—Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, 1 dc in each of next 5 dc, * ch 2, insert hook under both ch-4 loops and work 1 sc, ch 2, 1 dc in each of next 4 dc; repeat from * 3 times more, 1 dc in next dc, 1 dc in top of turning ch.

Row 4—Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, 1 dc in each of next 5 dc, * ch 4, 1 dc in each of next 4 dc; repeat from * 3 times more, 1 dc in next dc, 1 dc in top of turning ch.

Row 5—Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, 1 dc in next dc, * ch 4, skip next 4 dc, working in 2 top loops of ch, work 1 dc in each of next 4 ch; repeat from * 3 times more, ch 4, skip next 4 dc, 1 dc in next dc, 1 dc in top of turning ch.

Row 6. Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, 1 dc in next dc, * ch 4, 1 dc in each of next 4 dc; repeat from * 3 times more, ch 4, 1 dc in next dc, 1 dc in turning ch.

Row 7—Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, 1 dc in next dc, * ch 2, work 1 sc under both ch-4 loops as before, ch 2, 1 dc in each of next 4 dc; repeat from * 3 times more, ch 2, 1 sc under next 2 ch-4 loops, ch 2, 1 dc in next dc, 1 dc in turning ch.

Row 8-Repeat row 6.

Row 9—Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, 1 dc in next dc, working in 2 top loops of ch as before, work 1 dc in each of next 4 ch, * ch 4, skip 4 dc, 1 dc in each of next 4 ch; repeat from * 3 times more, 1 dc in next dc, 1 dc in top of turning ch.

Repeat rows 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8—about 8 ins. from beg. Fasten off.




With A, ch 35 for lower edge.


Row 1—right side—Work 1 dc in 4th ch from hook, 1 dc in each remaining ch; 33 dc counting turning ch as 1 dc.


Row 2—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in both loops of first dc, 1 sc in front loop of each remaining dc, end 1 sc in top of turning ch; 33 sc.

Row 3—Ch 3, turn, skip first sc, 1 dc in back loop of each sc to within 1 sc of end, 1 dc in both loops of last sc; 33 dc.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until 23 rows—about 8 ins. from beg. Fasten off.








No. 6

With B, ch 33 for lower edge.

Row 1—right side—Work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each remaining ch; 32 sc.

Row 2—Ch 3, turn, skip first sc, 1 dc in each remaining sc; 32 dc counting turning ch as 1 dc.

Row 3—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each dc, end 1 sc in top of turning ch; 32 sc. Repeat rows 2 and 3 until 23 rows—about 8 ins. from beg. Fasten off.




AVOID THIS SQUARE.

With B, ch 35 for lower edge.

Row 1—right side—Work 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook, 1 hdc in each remaining ch; 34 hdc counting turning ch as 1 hdc.

Row 2—Ch 2, turn, skip first hdc, 1 hdc in back loop of each remaining hdc, 1 hdc in top of turning ch; 34 hdc.

Repeat row 2 until 20 rows—about 8 ins. from beg. Fasten off.



No. 7 Multiple of 3 ch sts

With A, ch 34 for lower edge.

Row 1—right side—Work 1 dc in 4th ch from hook, 1 dc in each remaining ch; 32 dc counting turning ch as 1 dc.

Row 2—Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, 1 dc in each remaining dc, end 1 dc in top of turning ch.


Row 3—Repeat row 2.

Row 4—Ch 3, turn, skip first 2 dc, work 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc all in next dc—1 V-st made, * skip next 2 dc, 1 V-st in next dc; repeat from * to within 2 sts of end, skip next dc, 1 dc in top of turning ch; 10 V-sts, plus turning ch and 1 dc.

Row 5—Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, * 1 dc in next dc, 1 dc in ch 1, 1 dc in next dc; repeat from * across, end 1 dc in top of turning ch; 32 dc counting turning ch as 1 dc.

Rows 6 and 7—Repeat row 2.

Repeat last 4 rows until 15 rows-about 8 ins. from beg. Fasten off.



No. 9
Multiple of 2 ch sts

With A, ch 37 for lower edge.

Row 1—right side—1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, * insert hook in last ch used, yo and draw up a loop, skip next ch, insert hook in next ch, yo and draw up a loop, yo and through all 3 loops on hook, ch 1 *; repeat between *'s to within 1 ch of end, 1 sc in last ch; 17 pats., plus 1 sc each side.

Row 2—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in first sc, * draw up a loop in last st used, skip next st, draw up a loop in next st, yo and through all 3 loops on hook, ch 1 *; repeat between *'s to within 1 st of end, 1 sc in last st; 17 pats., plus 1 sc each side.

Repeat row 2 until 27 rows—about 8 ins. from beg. Fasten off.

No. 10 Multiple of 4 ch sts


With B, ch 36 for lower edge.

Row 1—right side—Work 1 dc in 4th ch from hook, skip next ch, 1 sc in next ch, * skip next ch, 1 shell of 3 dc in next ch, skip next ch, 1 sc in next ch; repeat from * to within 2 ch of end, skip next ch, 2 dc in last ch; 7 shells with half shell at each side.

Row 2—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in first dc, 1 shell in next sc, * 1 sc in center dc of next shell, 1 shell in next sc; repeat from * across, end 1 sc in top of turning ch; 8 shells.

Row 3—Ch 3, turn, 1 dc in first sc, 1 sc in center dc of next shell, * 1 shell in next sc, 1 sc in center dc of next shell; repeat from * across, end 2 dc in last sc.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until 21 rows—about 8 ins. from beg. Fasten off.



No. 11 Multiple of 2 ch sts


With A, ch 36 for lower edge.

Row 1—right side—Work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, * ch 1, skip Next ch, 1 sc in next ch; repeat from * across ch; 18 sc (35 sts).

Row 2—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in first sc, 1 sc in next ch-1 space, * ch 1, Skip next sc, 1 sc in next ch-1 space; repeat from * to within 1 sc of End 1 sc in last sc; 19 sc.

Row 3—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in first sc, * ch 1, skip next sc, 1 sc in next Ch-1 space; repeat from * to within 2 sc of end, ch 1, skip next sc, 1 s Sc in 15 last sc; 18 sc.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until 36 rows-about 8 ins. from beg. Fasten off




No. 12 Multiple of 2 ch sts

With B, ch 35 for lower edge.

Row 1—right side—Work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 sc in next ch, * skip next ch, 2 sc in next ch; repeat from * to within 2 ch of end, skip next ch, 1 sc in last ch; 34 sc.

Row 2—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, * skip 1 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * to within 2 sc of end, skip 1 sc, 1 sc in last sc; 34 sc. Repeat row 2 until 35 rows-about 8 ins, from beg. Fasten off.



No. 13

With A, ch 35 for lower edge.

Row 1-wrong side-Work 1 dc in 4th ch from hook, 1 dc in each remaining ch; 33 dc.

Note—Turning ch is counted as 1 dc.

Row 2—Ch 3, turn, 1 dc in back loop of 2nd dc, 1 dc in back loop of each remaining dc, 1-dc in top of turning ch.

Row 3—Ch 3, turn, 1 dc in both loops of 2nd dc, 1 dc in both loops of each remaining dc, 1 dc in top of turning ch.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until 16 rows—about 8 ins. from beg.

Fasten off.

Loop Trimming—Ch loops are worked from right side on surface of square, working into free loops of first and all odd-numbered rows.

V First Loop Row—With right side facing, join yarn as follows:—With A make loop on hook, work 1 sc in free loop of 2nd dc in first row of square, * ch 11, skip next 5 dc, 1 sc in free loop of next dc; repeat from * 4 times more; 5 ch loops. Fasten off.

√2nd Loop Row—With right side facing, join yarn as before in 2nd dc in 5th row of square, ch 5, insert hook into ch loop below and also into free loop of 5th dc in 3rd row of square, work 1 sc through loop and dc, fastening loop; * ch 11, insert hook into next ch loop, skip next 5 dc on 3rd row, insert hook into free loop of next dc, and work sc through loop and dc; repeat from * 3 times more, ch 5, 1 sc in free loop of 2nd dc from end of 5th row. Fasten off.

√3rd loop Row—With right side facing, join yarn with sl st in first sc of previous loop row, * ch 11, skip next 5 dc of same row, inserting hook into ch loop below and into next dc, work 1 sc; repeat from ' 3 times more, ch 11, skip 5 dc, join with sl st in last sc of previous


loop row. Fasten off.

√4th Loop Row—With right side facing, join yarn as before in 2nd dc in 9th row of square, ch 5, insert hook in free loop below and into 5th dc in 7th row of square, work 1 sc; * ch 11, insert hook into next ch loop, skip next 5 dc in 7th row, insert hook into next dc and work 1 sc; repeat from * 3 times more, ch 5, 1 sc in 2nd dc from end of 9th row.

Fasten off.

√ 5th Loop Row—Repeat 3rd loop row.

of th Loop Row-With right side facing, join yarn as before in 2nd dc in 13th row of square, ch 5, insert hook in free loop below and into



5th dc in 11th row of square, work 1 sc, * ch 11, insert hook into next ch loop, skip next 5 dc in 11th row, insert hook into next dc and work 1 sc; repeat from * 3 times more, ch 5, 1 sc in 2nd dc from end of 13th row. Fasten off.

7th Loop Row—With right side facing, join yarn with sl st in first sc of previous loop row, ch 5, work 1 sc in 5th dc of 15th row, ch 5, insert hook into next ch loop, skip next 5 dc on 13th row, insert hook into next dc and work 1 sc, * ch 5, skip next 5 dc on 15th row, sc in next dc, ch 5, skip next 5 dc on 13th row, sc through next loop and next dc; repeat from * 3 times more, end last repeat, ch 5, sl st in last sc of previous loop row. Fasten off.

Sew in ends.

No. 14

With B, ch 2 for center, work 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Round 2—Do not turn, working in back loop of each sc, work 3 sc in each of 4 sc; 12 sc. Mark last sc for end of round. Carry marker at end of each round. Note-All rounds are worked from right side, working into back loop of each sc.


Round 3-Do not turn, continue around working 1 sc in next sc, * 3 sc in next sc-center sc of corner, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc; repeat from * twice more, 3 sc in next sc, 1 sc in last sc of round; 20 sc.

Round 4-1 sc in each of next 2 sc, * 3 sc in next sc-center sc of corner, 1 sc in each of 4 sc; repeat from * twice more, 3 sc in next sc, 1 sc in each of last 2 sc of round; 28 sc.

Round 5—1 sc in each of next 3 sc, * 3 sc in corner sc, 1 sc in each of next 6 sc; repeat from * twice more, 3 sc in corner sc, 1 sc in each of next 3 sc: 36 sc.

Round 6—1 sc in each of next 4 sc, * 3 sc in corner sc, 1 sc in each of next 8 sc; repeat from * twice more, 3 sc in corner sc, 1 sc in each of next 4 sc; 44 sc.

Continue around in this way, working 3 sc in each corner sc every round until 19 rounds from beg., end at marker-about 8 ins. square; 148 sc. Work sc to within 1 sc of next corner, join with sl st in corner. Fasten off.



Roll - 10 str.

With A, ch 35 for lower edge.

Row 1—right side—Work 1 dc in 4th ch from hook, 1 dc in each remaining ch; 33 sts counting turning ch as 1 st.

Row 2—Ch 3, turn, skip first st, work 1 dc in front loop of each remaining st, 1 dc in top of turning ch; 33 sts.

Row 3—Ch 3, turn, skip first st, work 1 dc in back loop of each remaining st, 1 dc in top of turning ch.

Row 4—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in front loop of each st, 1 sc in top of turning ch.

Note—From now on work in both loops of sts up to and including row 30.

Row 5—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each of first 16 sts, work a bead st as follows;—holding the loop on hook, insert hook in next st, yo and draw up a loop, ch 3 in this loop only for bead, yo and through the 2 loops on hook to complete bead, keep bead on right side of work, 1 sc in each of last 16 sts.

Row 6 and all Even Numbered Rows up to and Including Row 30—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each st.

Row 7—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each of first 15 sts, 1 bead st in next st, 1 sc in next st, 1 bead st in next st, 1 sc in each of 15 sts to end.

Row 9—Ch 1, turn, work 14 sc, 1 bead st in next st, * 1 sc in next st, 1 bead st in next st; repeat from * once more, 14 sc to end.

Row 11—Ch 1, turn, work 13 sc, 1 bead st in next st, * 1 sc in next st, 1 bead st in next st; repeat from * twice more, 13 sc to end.

Row 13—Ch 1, turn, work 12 sc, 1 bead st in next st, * 1 sc in next st, 1 bead st in next st; repeat from * 3 times more, 12 sc to end.


Row 15—Ch 1, turn, work 11 sc, 1 bead st in next st, * 1 sc in next st, 1 bead st in next st; repeat from * 4 times more, 11 sc to end.

Row 17—Ch 1, turn, work 10 sc, 1 bead st in next st, * 1 sc in next st, 1 bead st in next st; repeat from * 5 times more, 10 sc to end.

Row 19—Repeat row 15.

Row 21—Repeat row 13.

Row 23—Repeat row 11.



Row 25—Repeat row 9.

Row 27—Repeat row 7.

Row 29—Repeat row 5.

Row 31—Ch 3, turn, skip first st, 1 dc in back loop of each st.

Row 32—Repeat row 2.

Row 33—Repeat row 3. Fasten off. About 8 ins. from beg.

No. 16

Round 1—right side—With B,ch 5, draw up a loop in 2nd ch from hook, mark ch just used, draw up a loop in each of next 3 ch, yo and draw through all 5 loops on hook—1 pat. made, * ch 5, draw up a loop in 2nd ch from hook, mark ch just used, draw up a loop in each of next 3 ch, yo and draw through all 5 loops on hook; repeat from * twice more, join with sl st in first ch of first pat.; 4 pats. at center.

NOTE—Do not turn, continue around working all rounds from right side.

Round 2—SI st along edge of first pat. up to and including first marked ch, * ch 8 for corner, sI st in marked ch of next pat.; repeat from * twice more, ch 8, join with sI st in sI st at top of first pat.; 4 corner loops. NOTE—Draw up all loops in back loop of each ch for pat.


Round 3—* Draw up a loop in each of first 4 ch of corner loop, yo and draw through all 5 loops, ch 8 for corner loop, draw up a loop in each of last 4 ch of same corner loop, yo and draw through all 5 loops, ch 4; repeat from * 3 times more; 8 pats., 4 corner loops.

End each round with ch 4.

Round 4—* Draw up a loop in each of first 4 ch of next corner loop, yo and draw through all 5 loops, ch 8 for corner loop, draw up a loop in each of last 4 ch of same corner loop, yo and draw through all 5 loops, ch 4, draw up a loop in each of next 4 ch, yo and through all 5 loops, ch 4; repeat from * 3 times more; 12 pats., 4 corner loops.

Round 5—* Work a pat. in first 4 ch of corner loop, ch 8, work a pat. in last 4 ch of same corner loop, + ch 4, work a pat. in next 4 ch +, repeat between +'s once, ch 4; repeat from * 3 times more; 16 pats., 4 corner loops.

Continue around in this way, having 4 more pats. in each successive round, until 11 pat. rounds from beg.—about 8 ins. square, join last ch 4 with sl st in first ch of corner loop. Fasten off.



No. 17 Multiple of 12 ch sts

With A, ch 32 for lower edge.

Row 1—right side—Work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each remaining ch; 31 sc. Mark 4th, 16th and 28th sc.

Row 2—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each sc.

Note—Work dc around post of st as follows:—Yo hook, insert hook from front to back in space before designated st, then from back to front on other side of same st, yo and draw up a loop, yo and through 2 loops, yo and through 2 loops, yo and through 2 loops.

Row 3—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each of first 3 sc, * work 1 dc around post of marked st in 2nd row below, skip next sc, 1 sc in each of next 11 sc *; repeat between *'s across, end last repeat 1 sc in each of last 3 instead of 11 sc.

Row 4—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each st; 31 sc.

Row 5—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each of first 2 sc, * work 1 dc around post of dc in 2nd row below, skip next sc, 1 sc in next sc, work 1 dc around post of same dc in 2nd row below, skip next sc, 1 sc in each of next 5 sc, mark last sc made, 1 sc in each of next 4 sc *; repeat between *'s across, end last repeat 1 sc in each of last 2 sc.

Row 6—Repeat row 4.

Row 7—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each of 9 sc, repeat between *'s of row 3 across, end last repeat 1 sc in each of 9 instead of 11 sc.

Row 8—Repeat row 4.

Row 9—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each of 4 sc, mark last sc made, 1 sc in each of next 4 sc, repeat between *'s of row 5 across, end last repeat 1 sc in each of 3 sc after marked sc.

Row 10-Repeat row 4.

Repeat rows 3 through 10 until there are 38 rows—about 8 ins. from beg., omit marking sts on row 37. Fasten off.




With B, ch 33 for lower edge.

Row 1—right side—Work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each remaining ch; 32 sc.

Row 2—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each sc.

Repeat row 2 until 40 rows—about 8 ins. from beg. Fasten off.





No. 19
Multiple of 4 ch sts

With A, ch 37 for lower edge.

Row 1—Work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each remaining ch; 36 sc. Row 2—right side—Ch 4, turn, skip first 3 sc, work 4 dc in next sc, * skip next 3 sc, 4 dc in next sc; repeat from * to within 4 sc of end, ch 1, skip 3 sc, 1 dc in last sc; 8 pats., plus turning ch and 1 dc.

Row 3—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in first dc, 1 sc in ch-1 space, * 1 sc in each of next 32 dc, 2 sc in last space; 36 sc.

Row 4—Ch 6, turn, skip first 2 sc, + * yo, insert hook in next sc, yo and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook; repeat from * 3 times more, yo and draw through all 5 loops on hook, ch 1 for eye, ch 3 more; repeat from + to within 2 sc of end, skip next sc, 1 dc in last sc. Row 5—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in first dc, * 3 sc in next space, 1 sc in ch-1 eye; repeat from * across, end 3 sc in last space; 36 sc.

Repeat rows 2, 3, 4 and 5 until 21 rows—about 8 ins. from beg. Fasten off.

No. 20 Multiple of 2 ch sts

With B, ch 36 for lower edge.

Note—Draw up loops about ½ in.

Row 1—right side—Yo, insert hook in 5th ch from hook, yo and draw up a loop, * yo, draw up a loop in same ch; repeat from * once, having 7 loops on hook, yo and draw through last 6 loops on hook, yo and draw through remaining 2 loops on hook-1 cluster made, † ch 1, skip 1 ch, yo, draw up a loop in next ch, ** yo, draw up a loop in same ch; repeat from ** once—7 loops on hook, yo and through 6 loops on hook, yo and through remaining 2 loops on hook—cluster made; repeat from † 14 times more, 1 dc in last ch; 16 clusters, plus turning ch and 1 dc. Row 14 Ch 1, turn, work 11 sc, dc around dc, skip 1 sc, work 6 sc, mark last sc for center st, work 5 sc, dc around dc, skip 1 sc, 11 sc

Row 16 Ch 1, turn, work 10 sc, dc around dc, skip 1 sc, work 5 sc, dc around marked st in 2nd row below, skip 1 sc, 1 sc in next sc, dc around same marked st, skip 1 sc, work 5 sc, dc around dc, skip 1 sc, 10 sc to end.

Row 18 Ch 1, turn, work 11 sc, dc around dc, skip 1 sc, * 3 sc, dc


around dc, skip 1 sc; repeat from * twice more, 11 sc to end.


/Row 20 Ch 1, turn, work 12 sc, * dc around dc, skip 1 sc, 1 sc in next sc, dc around dc, skip 1 sc *, work 5 sc, repeat between *'s once,

Row 22 Ch 1, turn, work 13 sc, * work dec. dc as follows:—yo, insert hook under next dc, yo and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook, yo, insert hook under next dc, yo and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook, yo and through remaining 3 loops *, skip 1 sc, work 7 sc, repeat between *'s once, skip 1 sc, 13 sc to end.

Row 24 × Ch 1, turn, work 12 sc, dc around 2nd half of dec. dc, skip next sc, sc in next sc, work dc around first half of dec. dc—a "right to left" twist-, skip 1 sc, work 5 sc, dc around 2nd half of dec. dc, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc, dc in top of dec. dc in 2nd row below-a "left to right" twist, skip next sc, 12 sc to end.

Row 26 ≥ Same as row 18.





Row 28 Ch 1, turn, work 10 sc, dc around dc, skip 1 sc, work 5 sc, dc around dc, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc, dc around dc, skip 1 sc, 5 sc, dc around dc, skip 1 sc, 10 sc to end.

Row 30 Ch 1, turn, work 11 sc, dc around dc, skip 1 sc, work 5 sc, repeat between *'s of row 22 once, skip 1 sc, work 5 sc, de around de, skip 1 sc, 11 sc to end.



Row 40—Ch 1, turn, work 16 sc, dc around dc, skip 1 sc, 1 sc in next sc, dc around dc, skip 1 sc, 16 sc to end. *

Row 42—Ch 1, turn, work 17 sc, repeat between *'s of row 22 once, skip 1 sc, 17 sc to end.

Row 43—Ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each st. Fasten off. About 8 ins. from beg.



STITCH GAUGE—Important—Afghans are planned on the basis of working to a specified number of stitches and rows to 1 inch; this is referred to as the GAUGE. Required gauge is given at beginning of instructions. If this gauge is not obtained the finished Afghan will not be the correct size.


The size crochet hook recommended will give the average worker the correct gauge. However, if you do not obtain the gauge required, change the size hook to conform to the tension of your individual work; if your work is too loose use smaller size hook to tighten gauge; if your work is too tight use larger size hook to loosen gauge. You MUST get gauge given to insure proper size of finished Afghan.

BLOCKING—With wrong side up, using rust-proof pins, pin out on padded surface to given measurements. Steam lightly with moderately hot iron over a wet cloth, taking care not to let weight of iron rest upon any one spot. Allow to dry before removing.


Note: Be sure to buy sufficient yarn of each color in the same dye lot number to complete the article. This is not necessary if you are buying Ever-Match Yarn.


LEARNING TO CROCHET

THE CHAIN STITCH IS THE FOUNDATION FOR MOST CROCHETING.

HOW TO MAKE A CHAIN-"ch"



STEP 1—Make a slip loop on crochet hook a few inches from end of yarn. Adjust yarn on left hand over forefinger. Hold crochet hook in right hand like a pencil.




STEP 2—Yarn over the hook from back to front, draw yarn through loop on hook; one chain stitch made.


Repeat Step 2 until chain is desired length, holding chain close to hook as it grows longer.

HOW TO WORK SINGLE CROCHET-"sc"

Ch desired length.



STEP 1—Insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, y o as before. Draw yarn through the chain—2 loops on hook—, y o, draw through both loops; one single crochet made. Work one single crochet in each remaining chain.




STEP 2—Ch 1, turn, work 1 sc in each st of previous row, inserting hook under both strands of st unless otherwise specified.

Repeat step 2 for desired number of rows.


Fasten off by breaking yarn a few inches from last st and drawing end through last loop.

HOW TO WORK DOUBLE CROCHET-"dc"

Ch required length.



STEP 1—Y O, insert hook in 3rd ch from hook, draw yarn through—3 loops on hook—, y o draw through 2 loops—2 loops on hook—, y o draw through remaining 2 loops; one double crochet made.



STEP 2—Ch 3, turn, work 1 dc in 2nd st from hook and each remaining st, inserting hook under both strands of st unless otherwise specified.


NOTE: Turning chain is counted as first st of each row. Repeat Step 2 for desired number of rows.

LEARNING TO CROCHET

HOW TO WORK HALF DOUBLE CROCHET-"hdc"

Ch required length.

STEP 1—Y o, insert hook into 3rd ch from hook, draw yarn through—3 loops on hook—. Draw through *all* 3 loops; one half double crochet made. Work 1 hdc in each remaining ch.




STEP 2—Ch 2 turn, work 1 hdc in *first* st from hook and each remaining st, inserting hook under both strands of st unless otherwise specified.

Repeat step 2 for desired number of rows.

HOW TO WORK TREBLE CROCHET-"tr"

Ch required length.




STEP 1—Y o twice, insert hook into 4th ch from hook, draw yarn through—4 loops on hook—, y o draw yarn through 2 loops—3 loops on hook—y o, draw through 2 loops—2 loops on hook—y o, draw through 2 remaining loops—one tr made. Work one tr in each remaining ch.

STEP 2—Ch 4, turn, work 1 tr in 2nd st from hook and in each remaining st inserting hook under both strands of st unless otherwise specified. Repeat step 2 for desired number of rows.

NOTE: Turning ch is counted as first st of each row.


HOW TO WORK A SLIP STITCH-"sl st"



When instructions call for sl st, insert hook into next st. y o, draw through st and loop on hook.

HOW TO WORK AFGHAN STITCH

STEP 1—With an afghan hook, work a ch the required length. **STEP 2**—Working in the horizontal strand at back of ch, draw up a loop in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch, retaining loops on hook. There will be the same number of loops on hook as original number of ch.



STEP 3—To complete row, work off loops in following manner: y o hook, draw through first loop on hook, *y o hook, draw through next 2 loops on hook; repeat from * until 1 loop remains on hook.

STEP 4—Counting the loop on hook as the first loop of the row, *insert hook under vertical bar of next st, y o hook, draw up a loop retaining it on hook; repeat from * to within 1 st of end, insert hook under both vertical bars of last st, y o hook, draw up a loop, retaining it on hook. There will be the same number of loops on hook as in Step 2.

Repeat Step 3.

Steps 3 and 4 make 1 row.

Repeat Steps 4 and 3 for desired length.
